EAGLE PROJECT My project included the construction of a 100'x3' wide stone pathway split into 2 sections by a flight of wooden stairs, connecting the lower parking lot of my church to the road. The flagstone was placed in an alternating pattern with a few



inches of screening underneath. The stairs were constructed using pressure treated lumber and included a 6' extension of decking to connect to the upper stone walkway. By providing an accessible and convenient path from the church to the road, this eliminates previous safety hazards of pedestrians walking along the church driveway alongside heavy traffic, worsened by seasonal weather conditions.
