Eagle Project My project consisted of a half-mile trail over a 300' drop in elevation, connecting the Brandywine Creek (at Springton Manor Farm) and the existing trail systems in the northern areas of Glenmoore. The trail will be maintained by the Wallace Township Trails Committee. In addition to clearing the trail, an 8' bench was installed as a rest area, 6x6 steps were dropped into slopes to ease the grade and signposts with laminated maps were strategically located throughout the existing trails and new trail.
